I would like to "Thank You" for your generous donation to the Food 'n Friends Programs. The monies that you raised will go to help in several ways.

The Breakfast Program and the Soup Kitchens will both benefit from your generosity.

The Soup Kitchens are able to purchase food at a much lower cost through the Greater Boston Food Bank. Last year the cost of food averaged .17 cents per pound. This helped us in serving over 38,000 meals in the 4 communities we have kitchens at.

The Breakfast Program, which delivers non perishable breakfast items to over 70 households in Attleboro, is not funded through the Greater Boston Food Bank, which means our cost are much higher. This program relies on the Community Impact Grant through United Way and the private donations of breakfast items and monetary donations from the public.

Again I can not thank you enough for the thoughtfulness and kindness that your group has shown to the Food 'n Friends. It is because of the generosity of groups like yours that we can make this all happen.
